
GREETINGS: In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Lyman, qualified to vote in Town affairs, to meet Thursday, June 15th, A.D., 2017 at 6:30 pm, at the Lyman Elementary School in said Town, then and there to act upon the following article to wit:

Article 56: Shall the Town of Lyman appropriate the sum of \$12,000.00 from 2016-2017 EMS Revenue Account, to offset a 2016-2017 projected budget shortfall for the Goodwins Mills Fire-Rescue full and part time personnel costs. The total projected budget shortfall is \$20,000.00 with Lyman's share being \$12,000.00. Any unused amount will carry forward. To be effective, the Town of Dayton must also vote to appropriate its share of such costs.


