

Notice of Assessment to Unknown Owner

Pursuant to Maine Revised Statute Title 36, Chapter 105, Section 557-A, The Town of Lyman hereby notifies the public of its intent to assess several lots of unknown owner. After reasonable search, no known owner within a minimum of 20 preceding tax years has been discovered for these lots. The Town asks that any party who believes they have right to any of the listed parcels contact the Assessor to provide evidence supporting their claim. Otherwise, these parcels will be subject to taxation and eventual lien as property of unknown owner.

At the present time, these lots do not have official names. They will be renamed if unclaimed at time of commitment, but are currently labeled on the Lyman 2017 Tax Maps as follows:

tax map 4, lot marked L1, a back lot off Carlisle Brook Road;
tax map 6, lot marked "unknown", a back lot near Ray Avenue;
tax map 7, lot marked "L1", a back lot off New Road;
tax map 9, lot marked "unknown", a back lot off Bartlett's Bridge Road.
