Waterboro Road, Lyman, Me. at 6:10 pm on Monday, May 6th, 2019 to consider input from the general public for that portion of Lords Mill Road (a/k/a Lord's Lane) to property of the Town of Lyman.

 laid out and used.


No damages to adjacent property owners, it is a pre-negotiated term between the Town of Lyman and abutting owner(s), their heirs and assigns.

No public easement shall be retained, except an easement for snowplow turnaround on the northeasterly section of the Lords Mill Bridge (a/k/a Lord's Lane) just beyond the Lords Mills Bridge (a/k/a/ Lord's Bridge). However, should any public utilities be located within the discontinued area, the above referenced Maine statute indications "An easement for public utility facilities necessary to provide or maintain service remains in a discontinued town way regardless of whether a public easement is retained." Any relocation or disturbance of existing utilities in the discontinued area would be subject to communication with and approval by the affected utility companies.
