

## PUBLIC NOTICE TOWN OF LYMAN

The Board of Selectmen understands the concerns of the Coronavirus (COVID-19) and currently working diligently on developing measures to protect our town and employees. Selectmen, Health Officer, GMFR Fire Chief are monitoring and adjusting to the ever-changing response to the virus.

It is our responsibility to protect our citizens and paying attention especially to our senior citizens.

To minimize the risk of exposure to employees, and the public, the following procedures will be taken:

Only the Swap Shop at the Transfer Station will be closed until further notice. Regular hours will continue.

We are asking everyone to practice "social distancing" until there is no longer a public health threat. Social distancing is advised to maintaining a distance of six (6) feet between you and other people when possible and will be practiced at Town Hall, Transfer Station, Bunganut Park, Athletic Fields and Chadbourne Field.

Effective Tuesday March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020 Town Hall will be closed to the public, until further notice, however the staff will be available by phone or email during normal business hours. The Town offers many services that can be done online or over the phone. If an individual cannot accomplish a need by phone or online, then contact the office and we will figure out the best way to assist you. There is also a drop off slot located to the left of the front door to drop off tax payments, building applications, plumbing applications etc. Strongly encourage payments be made by check, money order or bank check.
