Otherwise, drive out across the field to cemetery sign and park near it. Cemetery is behind the sign in the woods. Large trees need to be cut. The plaque on the granite rock is spelled incorrectly as "Volentine Hill." Should be (according to all available records) Valentine Hill.

#12 Capt. Ben Gould Lot. N43.31388W070.365454. Old Pump Road. From Route 35 about 1.3 mile on Mast Road on **L**. Go to pole #5 proceed **R** up second driveway to end and park to the left of shed. Cross back lawn on path bearing left to cemetery about 100 feet into the woods. Takes 45 minutes to mow. Rev. War vet. Contact is Roger Bergeron at 730-2506. Also Kathy Allen lives there. (NOTE: A headstone bearing the name of Louisa Bodycote is outside the Gould plot. Stories vary but according to her descendants Louisa's body was moved to the Alfred Cemetery.)

Takes 30 minutes to mow.

#24, #25 and #26 Joseph Small and Nathaniel Gould lots. N43.48749W070.63826. Take **R** off SWR on Jason's Way. Turn **R** on Avalon Lane. Continue through yard past "parking area" to left past farm house. Call Dean first (205-2365) to avoid issues. He's particular about brush, trees, where the cows cross, where cars park . . . the works. Cross pasture straight back behind the house and continue to an old logging road (Old Gould Road, we'll call it) just inside back edge of field. There are 3 cemeteries here. NOTE: GOODWINS MILLS AND CHADBOURNE CEMETERIES ARE NOT INCLUDING ON THE LCC LIST BECAUSE BOTH ARE PRIVATELY OPERATED AND STILL ACTIVE. CHADBOURNE HAS A “DESCENDANTS GROUP” CARING FOR IT.

NOTE: STATE LAW REQUIRES EACH MAINE TOWN TO MAINTAIN ITS ANCIENT CEMETERIES (VETERANS AND NON-VETERANS) AND REQUIRES THE TOWN TO PROVIDE FLAGS FOR ALL VETERANS’ GRAVES.

NOTE: STATE LAW ALSO REQUIRES LANDOWNERS TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO EACH SITE UNLESS THEY ARE WILLING TO TAKE OVER THE RESPONSIBILITY. IF NOT, THE TOWN IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CEMETERY PLUS 25 FEET AROUND THE PERIMETER FOR MAINTENANCE PURPOSES (PARTICULARLY TREE CUTTING). ANY TREE WITHIN 25 FEET OF THE CEMETERY CAN BE REMOVED IF IT IS THREATENING THE PLOT, ITS WALLS OR HEADSTONES.

LANDOWNER PERMISSION IS NOT REQUIRED AND LANDOWNERS CANNOT LEGALLY STOP LCC FROM ACCESSING THE PLOTS FOR CLEANING, MOWING OR REMOVING THREATENING TREES OR LIMBS.

STATE LAW (subsection 1101) REQUIRES THAT AN LCC MEMBER ASSESS EACH PLOT IN LYMAN ANNUALLY EVEN IF IT DOES NOT HAVE A VETERAN IN IT OR EVEN IT IS MAINTAINED BY THE LANDOWNER. ASSESSMENTS SHOULD BE CONDUCTED AT LEAST ANNUALLY, IDEALLY PRIOR TO MEMORIAL DAY.

WARNING: A FULLY RECOVERED PLOT CAN REVERT BACK TO BRUSH, BRIARS AND VINES IN JUST ONE YEAR!

THERE ARE 20 REVOLUTIONARY WAR VETERAN MARKERS IN LYMAN (PLACED IN 2024 WITH 12 MORE TO COME). THESE ARE BASED ON A MOCA LIST AND SHOULD BE ASSESSED ANNUALLY. IF THE MARKERS BEGIN TO SETTLE SIMPLY PICK UP THE MARKER, ADD TAMPED PEA GRAVEL AS NECESSARY AND REPLACE THE MARKER SO THAT IT IS ABOUT 2 INCHES ABOVE GROUND LEVEL.
