Hi Lindsay,

What we are proposing for the Town of Lyman is to put down a fully refundable deposit of \$7,500 now, with the other half (\$7,500) due at the time of implementation (for Lyman this would be 07/01/25 in alignment with your next fiscal year). With the total cost per year afterwards being \$15,000, with options to renew at this locked-in price for up to a further 9 years (so you would keep the \$15,000 price for 10 years). This would include full subscription to our new multi-tenant, cloud-based Financial Suite for local government, (the first all new financial solution in 25 years). This would include all hosting, data storage, training, migration from your old system, and implementation and set up in TownCloud. If TownCloud did not deliver a fully functional solution for Lyman with the same equivalent functionality as your existing solution, then we would refund your deposit of \$7,500 within 60 days of termination, provided that the cause of any delay was due to TownCloud, and not caused by the Town of Lyman - in which case we would need to extend out the date of your implementation accordingly...

As you know, we have been trying to educate folks about the choices out there for running financial, and counter transactions. TownCloud would offer personal and property tax billing and collections, BMV, transactions, cash receipting and balancing, fund accounting, and payroll.

Essentially, the choices are:

- 1) To remain on the same defunct and unsupported solution
- 2) Migrate to the 'new' web version which has proven to be unreliable and expensive
- 3) **Move over to TownCloud.** I would urge you to please consider this option very strongly, not least as this is technically the most advanced solution available, but also, because if you sign up with a fully refundable deposit before the end of the year, we will lock in your price for up to 10 years.
